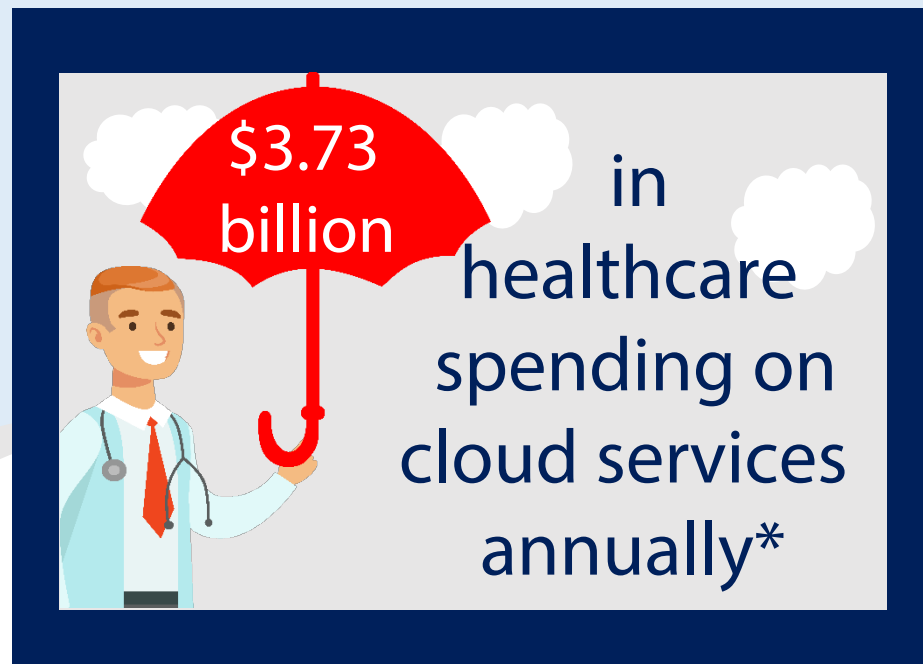


SAFE CLOUD STORAGE



WHAT IS THE CLOUD?

The practice of using a network of remote servers hosted on the Internet to store, manage, and process data, rather than a local server or a personal computer. Many of you already use the cloud to save and share pictures across your personal devices





CLOUD RISKS INCLUDE:

- LOSS OF DATA CONTROL
- POTENTIAL DATA BREACH
- UNAUTHORIZED ACCESS

WHERE DOES DATA IN THE CLOUD GO?

Data goes to large data centers with various levels of privacy and security. Because not all cloud data servers are secure, it is important to be really careful about what you save to the cloud, and which platform you use



Remember to not store any PHI unless absolutely necessary!



HOW SHOULD I USE THE CLOUD?

Do not store Banner Health information on an unapproved cloud platform



Do not share cloud login information or grant access to an unauthorized user
